Jewelry/Metalworking instructor, Dan Connelly, MFA, will monitor the studio and provide assistance and demonstrations as requested. Connelly is a nationally exhibited and recognized artist with over a decade of teaching experience in higher education (including several years at Kishwaukee College). He is familiar with a variety of techniques including lost wax casting, hydraulic press forming, rolling mill texturing, etching, forming and raising. He is an expert in the use of traditional hand tools combined with traditional skills and techniques for making jewelry and small metal art objects.

NOTE: Participants must participate in the Orientation Session on January 15 (6-7pm) prior to working in the studio.
