

## Basic Nurse Assistant Train-the-Trainer

The Basic Nurse Assistant Train-the-Trainer Instructor Course prepares nursing professionals in Illinois to teach a Basic Nursing Assistant Training Program (BNA-TP). The class is delivered in a “hybrid” format: a nine week combination of face-to-face class meetings and online components. This “35 contact hour” program has an Alzheimer’s disease component and is approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health. (Contact hours are non-credit hours, therefore, not applicable towards Kishwaukee College degree or certificate program requirements)

Interested parties must meet the following eligibility requirements to participate in the class:

- Current Illinois RN license
- Minimum of two years nursing experience
- One year of nursing experience working with the elderly (FYI - this requirement has changed)
- Experience in teaching theory in an accredited nursing program.
- Approval from Donna Kayes, Coordinator Basic Nursing Assistant program (815-825-9464)
