A Pharmacy Technician is a skilled, healthcare professional who is trained in pharmacy history, law, ethics, regulations, communication, calculations, drug information, practice settings, over the counter and alternative medicines. This program is designed to prepare participants to sit for the Certified Pharmacy Technician exam and to work in both a retail and hospital pharmacy setting.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), employment of pharmacy technicians is projected to grow 20 percent from 2012 to 2022, faster than the average for all occupations.

Salaries vary depending on experience, hours, and location. The median annual wage for pharmacy technicians was \$30,920 in May 2016.

This 100 hour program includes 70 hours of class time and 30 hours of externship in a local pharmacy.
